Water Staining or Damage Inside the Building Don't assume water stains on ceilings and walls indicate a plumbing issue. Any visible water inside the building warrants a roof inspection.

Bubbles or blisters indicate air and possible

moisture trapped between roof layers. If left unaddressed, this can lead to severe degradation and eventual roof failure.

Damaged Metal Flashing

Flashing plays a vital role in keeping moisture from penetrating your roofing system. Bent, cracked, dented, or corroded metal flashing must be repaired promptly.

onding Water

A little standing water after heavy rainfall is expected. However, water should drain or evaporate within 48 hours, and your drainage system may not be working correctly if it doesn't.

Musty Odors

Mold and mildew growth from water seepage often happens out of sight, making it hard to detect visually. Musty odors are a sure sign of moisture and need to be addressed.

Energy Bill Increase

Energy usage may fluctuate with the seasons, but it should stay more or less consistent from year to year. A sudden, unexpected change is often a sign of a roofing issue (typically, the reflective surfacing has worn off).



Recent Severe Weather

Severe storms (especially high winds, hail, and torrential rain) are a leading cause of roof damage. Inspecting your roof after severe weather is always a good idea.
